- pitch / short synopsis (maximum 150 words)
- synopsis / treatment (maximum 750 words)
- director's note on aesthetics and structure (maximum 450 words)
- biographical information on the director (max. 300 words)
- company profile (max. 300 words)
- budget, financing and coproduction partners in EURO (max. 300 words)

(The best is to send it in electronic form via E-mail.)

DEADLINE to submit projects from Central and Eastern Europe: **July 16, 2005**
