Before beginning her studies at the Academy of Music and Performing Arts in Bratislava she had already gathered rich experience with television films and series. During her studies, she made her debut on the film screen in the principal role of Valentina in CRUEL JOYS in 2002 (DIR. JURAJ NVOTA). The role of the Princess in the fairy tale THE DEVIL KNOWS WHY (DIR. ROMAN VÁVRA) followed in 2003. In 2005, she played the main role of Dana in the love romance from within the communist prison walls of 1950s A LITTLE PIECE OF HEAVEN (DIR. PETR NIKOLAEV) and, most recently she has one of the leading parts in the second feature film by Juraj Nvota, MUSIC, which is expected to open in 2007. Numerous film roles are accompanied by appearances

in several TV films and series in Slovakia, Czech Republic, as well as in Germany. Táňa is a well-respected theatre actress, known in Slovakia and in Czech Republic. For her performance she has received several awards, most recently the Slovak Annual Theatre Award "DOSKY 2006" and the Slovak Literary Fund Award 2006 for the best actress for the role of MANON LESCAUT staged by the Drama Company of the Slovak National Theatre. Táňa has gathered experience working for international co-production in Slovakia and in Czech Republic, her work includes a number of English spoken roles. She is very much attracted and open to face challenges of broader and intensive international work.
