



THE REGULATIONS OF THE CRACOW FILM MARKET

1

The Cracow Film Market is organized by the Cracow Film Foundation along with the Cracow Film Festival. Its main goal is to promote documentary and short film and to encourage contacts among film professionals.

2

Documentary, feature and animated films can participate in the Cracow Film Market.

3

Only the films chosen by the Cracow Film Festival selection committee for the international or national competition are automatically qualified to participate in the Cracow Film Market.

4

All the remaining films, regardless of whether they have been entered to the Festival's selection or not, shall be registered for the Market, based on a separate Film Market entry form.

5

Films which have participated in the previous edition of the Film Market, are excluded from this year's edition.

6

Entering a film to Market is free of charge.

7

The film being admitted to the Market, the Organizers shall provide the following services to all entrants:

- making the film available viewing to the Market guests on dvd/vhs provided by the entrant
- preparation of a list of persons who had viewed the film during the Market and delivering it to the entrant
- listing the film in the Market catalogue in two language versions – English and Polish, including synopsis and detailed contact information about the producer and the distributor
- listing the film in a database created after the closing of the Market and available on-line
- additionally, at the distributor's/producer's request, the Organizers may provide them with a special promotional stand.

Information included in the catalogue shall be based on the data listed in the entry form solely. No correction or completion of the information will be possible after the entry form has been received by the Organizers.

All the costs regarding the sending of the preview dvds, vhs-es, screening copies and possible advertising materials are born by the entrant.

10

Screeners used at the Market (including those which the Festival receives for selection) will not be sent back to the entrants after the closing of the Market, unless the entrant covers the costs of dispatch.

11

One accreditation will be granted for a representative of each film for the whole duration of the Cracow Film Market. No gratuitous Festival accreditation, passes or tickets will be issued to the representatives of the Market films.

12

Participation in the Cracow Film Market requires a personal Market badge. It shall be issued to the accredited guests of the Cracow Film Festival after an additional payment of 20 PLN (5 €). The fee for a badge that entitles the owner to access the Market solely is 100 PLN (5 €).

13

Entry of the film in the Cracow Film Market means consent to making the films available for viewing to Market guests on vhs or dvd.

Vhs cassettes and dvds along with duly and legibly filled in entry forms should reach the following address before **31st March 2006**:

The entrant may provide the Organizers with promotional materials for the film(s) entered (posters, flyers, brochures). Their distribution and exposition is up to the Organizers.

16

Only the screeners with English subtitles shall be accepted at the Market.

17

The Organizers of the Market refrain from any qualitative evaluation of the films entered. Complying with the formal conditions of entry listed in these regulations is the sole condition of a film's admission to the Market.

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Entry of a film in the Cracow Film Market means acceptance of these regulations.
