Animation Production Course

FOCUS

The hands-on exercise based workshop effectively simulates a production environment from the perspective of a producer, a team manager, recruitment manager etc. The focus of the course is to train participants in the most singularly important aspect of an animation production – production management itself. BZ Petroff, a seasoned production professional with experience from the biggest American studios with over 25 years of experience, will focus every day on a single format, such as a short film, commercial advertising, TV series, a feature animation film, a video game and even visual FXs.

Every day students will have a series of lectures and exercises to practice how to budget a project (based on a provided storyboard), manage a team and other production techniques.

Students will also have a chance to bring in their own finished storyboard for on-on-one consulting session with the lecturer or other project documentations and then will start working on the project under a direct supervision and lecturing of an industry professional in order to practically understand the workflow and management of an animation production.

Other topics will be mentioned such as co-productions, over-seas talent outsourcing, recruitment, team management, problem solving ...

ACCOMODATION

Masterclasses are going to be held in facility of The European Training Center in the town of Litomysl (about 140km from Prague). Premises are part of the renowned Renaissance castle complex and in particular its old brewery house, which will provide very unique environment for participants to focus and get most out of the Masterclasses.

Accommodation for participants is available right in the same premises where Masterclasses are going to be held, in the old brewery house offering accommodation in two categories. The northern wing is available 8 and a triple star rooms with a total capacity of 15 beds. Three rooms have a view of the castle courtyard, the rest are duplex. In the southern flank are 15 rooms with 40 beds. This accommodation is hostel type with private bathroom.

Accommodation is not included in tuition fee of Masterclasses.

Prices are following:

250 CZK / 10 EUR per night - including breakfast 200 CZK / 8 EUR per night - without breakfast

However, participants are free to find their own lodging in Litomysl if the ESC rooms are not convenient.
